

How do you store expressed milk?

If you're storing expressed milk at your baby's child care facility,add your baby's name to the label. Place the containers in the back of the refrigerator or freezer, where the temperature is the coolest. If you don't have access to a refrigerator or freezer, store the milk temporarily in an insulated cooler with ice packs.

How much breast milk can you carry on a plane?

You can carry more than 3.4 ouncesof breast milk in your carry-on bag, as well as ice and gel packs. The Transportation Security Administration (TSA) has specific screening procedures for anyone traveling with breast milk. Consider keeping a copy of the TSA regulations in your carry-on bag.

How do you store baby milk in a freezer?

When it's time to feed your baby, simply grab the baggie at the bottom, which helps you use the oldest milk first.
